- The Rich Valley Fair Horse Show is NOT sanctioned by USEF. However, every class offered herein which is covered by the rules and specifications of the current USEF Rulebook will be conducted and judged in accordance therewith. It is the exhibitor's responsibility to submit entries that do not constitute a violation of these provisions.
- The Rich Valley Horse Show is affiliated with the East Tennessee Saddlebred Association (ETSA), American Saddlebred Horse Association (ASHA), and American Saddlebred Horse Show Association of Virginia (ASHAV).
- The on-call veterinarian(s) are just that – on-call. If you have an emergency, you may call Crab Orchard Veterinary Services at (276) 988-8080. Please be mindful that they serve a broad area of clientele for both large and small animals and may be unable to respond immediately.
- **STALLS:** There are a limited number of stalls available for \$15 each on a first come, first serve basis. Please call **Tammy Gillespie at 276-624-3502** to reserve stalls. Stall fees or an open check

must be mailed to **Rich Valley Fair Horse Show, P.O. Box 1034 Saltville, VA 24370**, within 3 days of making the reservation. Failure to do so will result in cancellation of the stall reservation. Reservations made within 7 days of the show's commencement are payable at the show office at the time of registration.

- Exhibitors showing off a trailer are asked to park only in the designated areas. This will ensure a smooth traffic flow and keep horses and people safe.
- **ADMISSION:** Rich Valley Fair admission prices will be enforced for both days of the horse show -- \$5 for adults, \$2 for children ages 6-12, and free admission for children 5 and under. **Upon request, exhibitors will be issued a ticket by the gate attendant upon payment of admission fee. Tickets brought to the horse show office at the time of registration will be deducted from the exhibitor's entry fee totals.**
- **PARKING:** Spectators are asked to park in designated parking areas. Please keep parking areas around the barns free for owners, trainers, and exhibitors.
- **ARRIVAL AND DEPARTURE:** Horses will be permitted on the show grounds starting at 12:00 noon on Friday, July 26th. The grounds must be vacated no later than 12:00 noon on Sunday, June 28th.
- **ENTRIES:** New entries will only be accepted up to one hour prior to the start of the session. There are NO exceptions.
- Homemade and/or previously used back numbers are permitted; however, if an entry in a class has already registered with the same number, the second entrant must use one of the numbers provided at the registration booth.
- **FEES:** The horse show will enforce an OPEN CHECK POLICY. Fees must be paid in full or an open check must be left in the office before back numbers will be released. Failure to settle an account within 1 hour after the end of the show gives the Horse Show Secretary authority to fill in the correct amount owed to the Horse Show. Any check returned for non-payment will be charged a \$50 handling fee and must be replaced by a certified check or money order.
- **CHAMPIONSHIP CLASSES:** To be eligible to compete in a championship class, horses must be entered, shown, and judged in a qualifying class in its division or section.
- **GATE CALL:** There will be a 2-minute gate call commencing after the first horse enters the ring unless a hold has been announced. Judging will not start until the gate is officially closed. Holds must be requested at the time of registration
- **HEALTH REQUIREMENTS:** State law mandates that each horse on the show grounds must possess a negative Coggins Test executed within the past 12 months. A copy of the coggins must be submitted with each entry.
- All pets must be on a leash.
- Use of alcohol or drugs while on Rich Valley Fair Association property is strictly prohibited. Smyth County Sheriff's Office will be on the grounds conducting patrols for every show session.
- Proper attire for timed events consists of long-sleeved shirts, jeans or other long pants, and boots. Hats are optional and protective head gear is encouraged.
- **INDEMNITY:** All exhibitors, owners, trainers, or employees, upon entrance to the fairgrounds, agree to indemnify, save, and hold harmless the Rich Valley Fair Association and all volunteers, officials, employees, or sponsors of same from any and all claims arising from his or her use of the fairgrounds during the Rich Valley Fair Horse Show.
